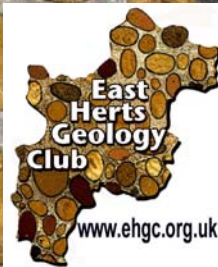


THE PUDDINGSTONE POW-WOW
